CONDITIONS OF MEET

- ☠ The meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA and local rules.
- ☠ Participation at this meet is restricted to Pirates Swim Team and Seadog members only.
- ☠ **No entry fees** - this is a great chance to experience racing in a fun and supportive learning environment.
- ☠ Times for our registered swimmers from this event will be posted in the SNZ database but will be recorded as non-SNZ approved meet. Therefore, these times will not be able to be used as qualifying times for Tier 1, Swimming Wellington or SNZ championships. Seadogs participants will receive their times directly from the timekeeper.
- ☠ **There will be no disqualifications**, rather the referee will issue a "Skills to work on" sheet. This should go to the coaches to assist in identifying potential skills that might need some attention before competing at an approved meet level.
- ☠ **How to enter:**
 - For **Pirates Swim Team**, enter via the SNZ Database, My Portal, entries close **Saturday 17th October at midday**.
 - For **Seadogs** please sign up on the noticeboard on Tuesday 13th October at your Tuesday night session, or to the email address on this flyer.
- ☠ No times will be accepted.
- ☠ The meet is marshalled. Swimmers will sit in a swimmer designated area on the benches on the east side of the pool and marshalling will be next to the slide.
- ☠ Officials/helpers – we need help to run this meet. You will be asked to help with the following jobs:
 - Timekeeper – great opportunity to learn how to do this
 - Team Manager, marshals and IOT's
 - BBQ/refreshments, office or official photographer
 - Does your swimmer want to attend, but you have other commitments? Please enter your swimmer and then contact us to have a volunteer opt out applied for this meet.
- ☠ Pool entry is free for swimmers and officials. Spectators are to sit on the west side of the pool by the Pirates noticeboard. You are welcome to bring your own deck chair.
